

Territorial Planning and Management of Urban and Rural Settlements – Bologna master degree

In order to be able to smoothly align performances, qualifications and certifications of graduates according to the European standards, mechanisms and realities the traditional higher education had introduced the educational programmes of master degrees, following the main principles of:

- Diversifying the professional training through introducing and using the transferable credits.
- Defining the degree of specialization through highly specialized disciplines.

This programme is firstly addressing to territorial planning, geography, and environmental studies graduates or associate fields such as sociology, humanities and economics following the same elements of training

The educational programme has been designed for two years of studies based on a plan structured into 4 semesters comprising fundamental, optional and facultative disciplines in addition to the time slot destined to dissertation. Disciplines can be yearly or semesterly in length and most of them have vocational and applied character.
