CIVIS - New horizon for the European-African partnership

After 3 intense and cheerful days, the conference *New Horizons for the European-African Partnership*, co-hosted by CIVIS and AMU as part of the French Presidency of the Council of the European Council has come to an end.

From 9th-11th March in Marseille, a mix of public and closed sessions gathered more than a hundred of academics, administrative staff and representatives of institutions from both sides of the Mediterranean, including numerous representatives of the European Commission. The conference registered 150 online participants.

Thanks to the hard work of WP5, coordinated by Christian Möllman from UT, the ten CIVIS members and the six leading African universities, now officially committed as associated partners, concluded the event with a joint position paper that issued a clear call for a European University Initiative which is open to global partnerships.
