policy recommendations**

[Last March in Strasbourg](#), 275 students from 30 countries, 142 universities and various backgrounds had the opportunity to participate at the first European Student Assembly.

As testified in [this article](#) wrote by one of our CIVIS Ambassador, this was the occasion to reunite students from the 41 European Universities Initiative Alliances. CIVIS was indeed represented by 17 CIVIS student council members and ambassadors.

Part of the Conference on the future of Europe global agenda, this inaugural session was the first of a series of gatherings that will give students a public voice in the European Union.
