DG EAC Document - CIVIS3i as good practice

As previously pointed out, the first CIVIS3i call for PostDoctoral Fellowships broke records with nearly 300 project proposals.

This CIVIS call aims to build up a solid case in preparation of a possible joint response to the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA). By increasing the visibility of our laboratories at European level, the mobility and intra-CIVIS collaborations and the overall attractiveness of CIVIS.

The CIVIS3i initiative's methodology has been highlighted in a DG EAC document, as an example of good practice for possibilities of articulating the MSCA and the European Universities Initiative (EUI)

Thanks to the unique dissemination and inspiring work that took place during last month conference in Marseille, the alliance clear call for a European University Initiative more open to global partnership is making its way successfully!

Peter Maasen, keynote speaker at the conference and professor at the universities of Oslo in Norway and Stellenbosch in South Africa has published a stimulating article on the subject. Taking the CIVIS conference as a good practice example which contributes to pave the way forward for African-European university collaboration.

Now that the partnership has been officialised, WP5 is already starting to conduct active collaboration projects with the African partners. These pilot activities will keep the CIVIS initiative at the forefront of the EUI dissemination work on this subject.

For your information, on 17th May a conference will be held in Marseille by the Friche de la Belle de Mai and the AFD Campus (French Development Agency) on cultural third places as modes of cooperation between Africa and France.

Among the participating countries, Morocco, Mozambique, Senegal, Tunisia and South Africa will be represented, this blended event could be of great interest, especially for WP3 and WP5 members.
