New - Mobility initiatives in CIVIS 1

Following the decision of the Steering Committee and discussion in the PMT in Athens, the coordination team is now able to centralise and monitor mobility initiatives to be organised with the remaining budget.

Are eligible: activities implemented before Sept 23rd 2022, organised at one of the Alliance's member universities, or at an associated partner African university by every Hubs, WP/TF leaders, academics involved in disciplinary meetings, Student Council members...

CIVIS Project Managers must be informed of the initiatives proposed by their university.

CALL - 33 BIPs submitted applications

CIVIS received 33 submitted application in response to the first call for Blended Intensive Programmes (BIPs) launched beginning of March.

WP6-members of the coordinating institution of the BIP proposal will check the eligibility while in parallel, Hubs Councils will evaluate the quality of the content.

As a reminder, this is a new Erasmus+ action and CIVIS maintains a permanent BIP call ([link website](#)) with two submission deadlines per year (**next November 30th**)

Launch of the CIVIS Hub 5 - Call for nomination

Great news, during the BoR that took place in Athens on the 20th May, Rectors approved [WP4 TF recommendation](#) for the establishment of the fifth and last Hub of CIVIS:

Hub 5 Digital and Technological Transformation

A call for nomination to start forming the Hub 5 Council has been launched until **10th June**. Like the other Hubs Councils, the Hub 5 council consists of members from all CIVIS universities, considered as experts in the respective Hub's thematic.

The Hub Council will be co-chaired by UAM and UB.

CIVIS Orchestra Academy - Video about the experience
