EC event at AMU - How to engage with the Mission “Restore our Ocean and Waters by 2030”

Following the One Ocean Summit held in Brest from 9 to 11 February 2022, the European Commission together with Aix-Marseille University (AMU), the Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur Region, the Pôle Mer Méditerranéen and the City of Marseille, will organise on **June 13 and 14, 2022** in Marseille a conference to support and strengthen the implementation of the European Mission "Restore our Ocean and Waters" and its Mediterranean lighthouse. The conference will bring together Member States, Associated Countries from around the Mediterranean, intergovernmental organisations and a wide range of stakeholders.

The event aims to broaden the mobilisation of public and private actors contributing to accelerate the transition to zero pollution in the Mediterranean Sea as part of the Mission "Restore our Ocean and Waters by 2030".
