## Event PFUE - Versailles

Over 600 people, representing alliances, agencies, and the European Commission gathered on **30th June at Versailles** for the last day of the French Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

On this occasion, the [CIVIS delegation](#) got the opportunity to meet and exchange with our counterparts, which were almost all represented (37 alliances out of 41, [see the booklet for more information](#)), and also had the pleasure to present CIVIS to Higher Education, Research & Innovation French Minister Sylvie Retailleau.

She was especially interested in CIVIS's ambition towards a EUNIV open to European-African partnership, illustrated by our 6 african strategic partners universities ([interviews of our partners are available on the civis website](#)). Ms Retailleau indeed reminded at her press conference that EUNIV "must open up even more internationally by sharing good practice with non-European partners through joint programmes".

The civic engagement pillar of our alliance did not go unnoticed by the HERI Minister, the interest was on CIVIS's work towards a more interdisciplinary and transnational approach of civic engagement through our Hubs and Open Labs.

In line with the Commission recommendations, the French Presidency works during the past 6 months has put on the Council's agenda four crucial points for the future of the EUNIV, and CIVIS:

- to enhance the European dimension of joint training,
- to enable the alliances to recruit jointly,

- to pool their resources if they so wish,
- and to award diplomas with a European dimension
