AMU is hosting **next week** the kick-off Meeting of the second phase of development of CIVIS.

At this occasion, key actors from the new "CIVIS 2" structure have been invited to come to Aix-en-Provence to meet and officially kick-off this exciting new step of the Alliance!

From 8th to 10th November, the KoM will gathers 100 people on-site: members from the Board of Rector and Steering Committee, African strategic partners universities, Student Council chairs, coordination team, Institutional Coordinators, Officers, Heads of Units, Hubs and Open Labs representatives.
