It is open to all CIVIS faculty members and researchers and will fund proposals of mobilities for initiating new collaborative research projects or the preparation of applications for larger research grants between CIVIS member institutions in Europe and strategic partner universities in Africa.

Hubs Councils will be crucial for promoting the call within their networks and they will be part of the evaluation process of the submitted proposals **from April 8th**.
